1. Homeowner Comments

- Jerry from lake desire about the waterstone punch through, built by harbor homes. 4 lots with 4 acres with wetlands. They will be building 23 homes on the property. Traffic will more than likely come through the parks. He left a petition for us to sign. Concerns about traffic and detention pond. Sign at the club house
- People with past due balances, what are we doing. Should we open us to litigation and go after those homes.
- What about higher management companies? We had a volunteer step up, and we will contact Josh
- What about the other development off of 188th, what is going on with that? Melissa gave us the update and only 6 homes will have access to 188th

- Josh talked about speeding, engage Jordan again about placement of the speed sign. Also, maybe higher a sheriff to patrol. Or add some cross walks to slow people down.

- Have a drive in for a few hours with signs to encourage people to slow down
- Homeowner violations, what are we doing? We need to start enforcing better, more aggressive
